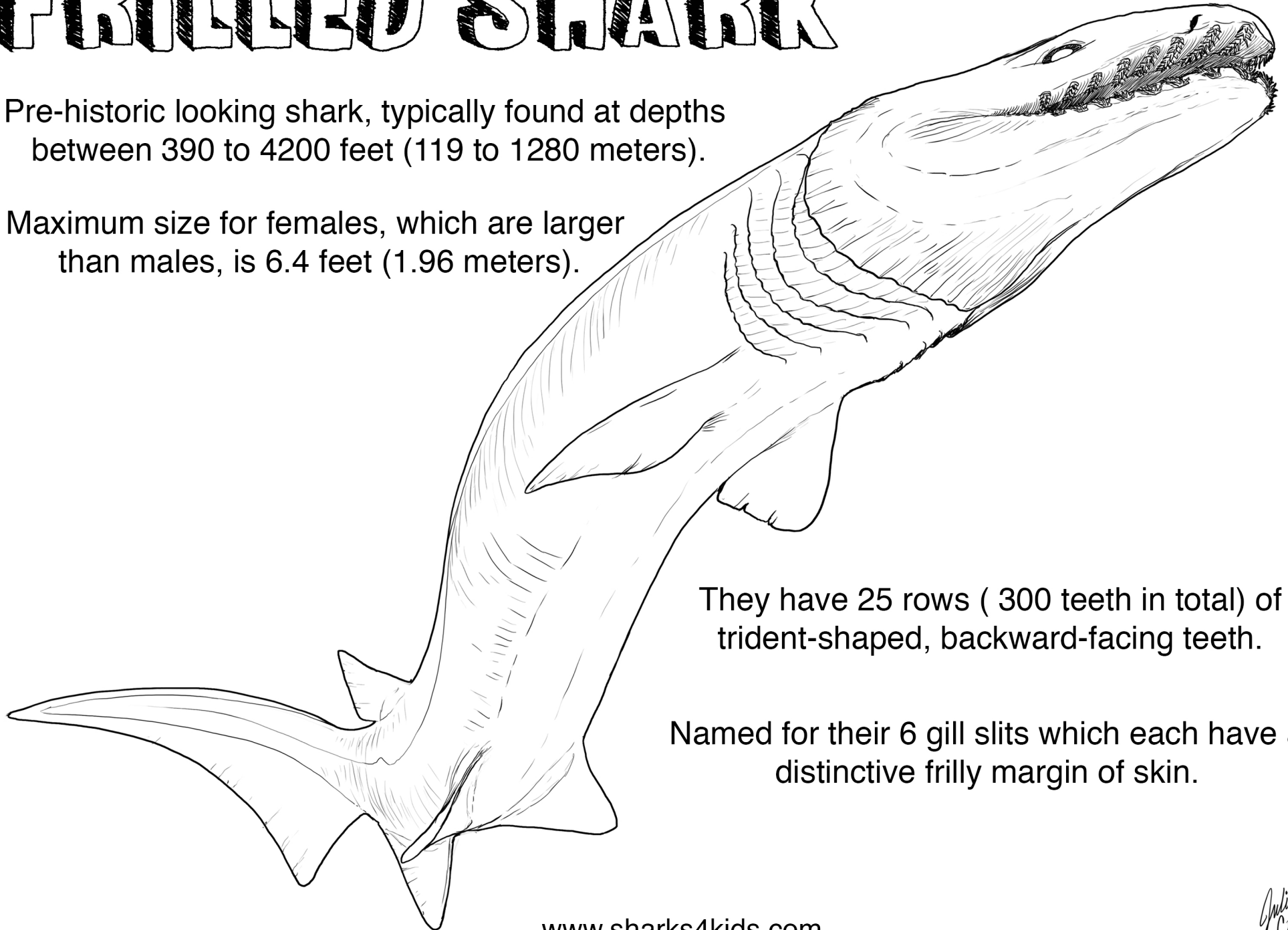


# FRILLED SHARK

(*Chlamydoselachus anguineus*)

Pre-historic looking shark, typically found at depths between 390 to 4200 feet (119 to 1280 meters).

Maximum size for females, which are larger than males, is 6.4 feet (1.96 meters).



They have 25 rows ( 300 teeth in total) of trident-shaped, backward-facing teeth.

Named for their 6 gill slits which each have a distinctive frilly margin of skin.
